

What's That Noise You Hear When Turning the Wheel?

If you hear a deep growling sound when making extreme turns, your vehicle may be low on power steering fluid.

Pop the hood and check the power steering dipstick. It should be clearly marked. Refer to your owner's manual for details on how to properly read the stick and which type of fluid is recommended.

If your power steering fluid level is low, add the appropriate amount. While you're at it, check for signs of a leak. If you notice a puddle of red or brown liquid on your driveway or garage floor, stop by any one of our Raffield Tire locations.
